PHPSAA Committee Descriptions

Mentoring & Training Committee

This committee works closely with both the PHPSAA and the PHPS Liaison Committee to administer the PHPS Mentoring Program. This program matches PHPS alumni with current specialists. Committee members help recruit alumni to be mentors and assist with other aspects of monitoring and evaluating the Mentoring Program.

Communications & Networking Committee

This committee will work to improve communications among alumni and current Prevention Specialists. The committee plans to create an alumni directory, maintain an interactive PHPSAA website, and enhance the current PHPSAA newsletter. In addition, the committee will explore the option of including an alumni news column in the PHPS Perspectives newsletter.

Recruitment & Membership Committee

This committee will work to create a systematic process for recruiting and retaining alumni members to PHPSAA. Committee members will focus on increasing membership, enhancing the benefits of membership, and improving methods for communicating these benefits to all PHPS Specialists. The Committee will also explore ways to better market the PHPSAA to alumni and current specialists.

Social Activities Committee

The Social Activities Committee plans and coordinates social events in conjunction with official PHPS and/or major public health activities (e.g. PHPS annual conference, APHA annual meeting). The Committee has established criteria and guidelines for events that are eligible for PHPSAA sponsorship and financial support.
